

How to Get Started:

- 1. Apply for official organizational status through your school's student government association. Chapters should be named "Students Ending Slavery."
- 2. Register your chapter through your university IT office to get an official email. This will be the best way for Free the Slaves HQ to communicate with you! Emails should be freetheslaves@yourschool.edu
- 3. Recruit members on campus with our marketing materials; you can print out our slavery fact sheet and the Free the Slaves One Pager:

- 4. Create a Facebook page for your chapter as a means to communicate with members, FTS and other chapters.
- 5. Once your chapter is launched, register with FTS by sending the following information to jenny.ly@freetheslaves.net.

 - c. Faculty Advisor
 - d. Official Chapter Email
 - e. Mailing Address
 - f. Chapter Facebook Page Address
 - g. A semester goal for your chapter (ex. We want to raise \$500 for FTS)
 - h. Comments/Questions
